When: Sunday, November 25, 2012 9:00 am - 1:30 pm

**Drop-off location:** The drop-off location is at 160 Ahui Street in Kaka'ako. This is a large parking lot located across the street from the Children's Discovery Museum, close to Kaka'ako Waterfront Park. The Toys for Tots collection trucks will be in this parking lot. You can drop off your toys any time between 9:00 am and 1:30 pm.
